MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 4:28 pm

ROLL CALL: Quorum achieved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes read and accepted, unanimously approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Savings Account Balance \$70,219.68 Checking Account

Balance \$4,176.24. The President will speak with Bookkeeper regarding any temporary cash flow issues for December. Issue should be easily resolved with first quarter funds coming on January 1st, 2023.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Discussion regarding Election and Annual meeting comments.
- 2. Discussion regarding slanderous comments and defamatory flier prior to Election
- 3. Discussed results of ballot measure pertaining to Annual Review.
- 4. Sunday Drive construction is moving along rapidly.
- 5. Proposed FEMA flood plain map will be implemented in approximately 2 years. Flood insurance can be purchased from the Federal Government up to \$250,000. Private insurance companies will insure for a higher amount. The Sport Court Facility is not insurable for flooding.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussed process and cost of conducting an Annual Review vs Audit. Board Voted unanimously to hire Schwindt and Co., to conduct the first audit of the HOA at a cost of approximately \$4-5,000. Annual Reviews would be conducted for the ensuing years, including the fiscal year that just ended, and will cost approximately \$3,000.
- Contract for landscaping maintenance was put out for competitive bidding. Three
 comparable companies and Rexius submitted bids. Rexius was still the most
 competitive by \$1000 or more on a monthly basis. Board voted unanimously to
 continue contract with Rexius.
- 3. Dale Riddle is networking to help find and hire a new attorney for HOA.
- 4. Explanation of new Resolution clarifying document requests from residents. Board decided to follow State of Oregon HOA guidelines with a few additions. Board voted unanimously to pass the new Resolution. It will be posted to the webpage and sent out with the next newsletter.
- 5. Brief discussion regarding downsizing the number of Board members from 5 to 3, as stated in Bylaws. Three is the minimum required by HOA Bylaws and by the State of Oregon. The State requires a President, Secretary, and a Treasurer is optional if the Board hires a Bookkeeper. Board has the option of appointing residents to other committees related to the running of the HOA, that are non-board positions. Board voted unanimously to table the matter until the next meeting.

- 6. Spray paint graffiti on cinder block walls has been removed thanks to Ron Sammons and Kirk Garner volunteering to power wash the areas.
